School App

Best means of communication

MyChildatSchool

One simple app, countless problems solved



MyChildAtSchool is an online portal that enables parents to view their child's performance at school in real time. Access is via a web browser or an app (for Android or iOS) and offers visibility of attendance, behaviour, assessment, student reports, letters, important documents and much more. It also provides a School shop front, taking online payments for anything from Trips, Clubs and Meals to Uniforms, Donations and Products.



Access to Real-time Data

All the data is in real time so a parent can instantly see whether his/her child is in school now.



Personal Account Settings

Parents can update their personal contact details online so that the school always has their most up to date information.



Announcements

Allows the school to communicate with all parents or focus on a selected audience based on student groups, including attaching documents.



Timetable and Academic Calendar

Parents can see which lessons their child has and with whom as well as having access to school events in calendar format.
